

Cote Gourmet's metamorphosis is complete with Madame Amina, Chef Extraordinaire. A world traveler sailing with her husband, Matteo the captain, her tantalizing flavors, spices and inspiration have been selectively gathered from exotic ports of call.

Please call her Amina, *ami* being French for friend. She eschews the *Madame* title, although it's her due, with her welcoming presence into a gourmet salon. Redecorated with nature's fresh influences, Cote Gourmet has become a haven for those seeking a global adventure for their palate and gracious dining experience.

Journeying on to the menu, you'll encounter influences not only French but also Italian, Middle Eastern, Spanish, Caribbean, Far Eastern and world-wide to the far flung tropical isles. Some of her signature dishes are your favorite meats, including lamb chops, t-bone and skirt steaks, filet mignon, and an incredible, hand-chopped filet mignon steak tartare. These all are our American favorites, but done with a subtle infusion of spices, herbs and natural au jus. Salmon and trout almondine arrive garbed in a lovely arrangement of herbs, edible flowers, color-drenched lotus roots, and fresh sprig garnishes. Don't miss the pastas, Cacio & Pepe black tagliolini, (Roman goat cheese and 3 peppers, black, green and pink), sprinkled with lemon zest.



Sunday Brunch presents an *a la carte* selection of eclectic crepes, specialty omelets, eggs benedict layered with salmon, and Belgian waffles for the kids. A mimosa welcome greets guests from 10AM until 3PM.

Chef Amina shops locally, and organically from either the Upper Eastside Biscayne Blvd. farmer's market or direct from Homestead's earthen fields. Miami Shores Sunday Farmer's Market also sees Amina shopping with her market basket, when in season.

Ardoise, Amina's daily specials, have recently included garlicky escargot, soupe de poisson, fresh Mediterranean Sea Bass alla Bellavista, and other inspirational small dishes and entrees. Perhaps we should call them her whims of the day? Chosen from amongst the copious fresh ingredients, and



the juiciest meats and fish, as we visit, we enrich our vocabulary of culinary tastes and authentic French language expressions. *Bon appetit!*

MOUNT SINAI MEDICAL CENTER OF FLORIDA FITCH UPGRADES MOUNT SINAI MEDICAL CENTER OF FLORIDA (FL) REVENUE BONDS TO 'A-' OUTLOOK STABLE

Miami Beach, FL - June 8, 2018 - Fitch Ratings has assigned an 'A-' Issuer Default Rating (IDR) to Mount Sinai Medical Center of Florida and has upgraded to 'A-' from 'BBB+' debt issued by City of Miami Beach Health Facilities Authority on behalf of Mount Sinai.

The 'A-' IDR reflects Mount Sinai's solid operating performance, which Fitch expects will continue. Mount Sinai is in the process of constructing a new surgical tower and emergency center at its main location on Miami Beach, as well as a freestanding emergency department in Hialeah. The new facilities are scheduled to open late 2018.

In the first half of 2018, the medical center received numerous awards and accolades related to financial stability, patient experience and safety including being named one of the nation's 100 Top Hospitals by IBM Watson Health.

Bringing performances from down the street and around the world.

Elizabeth 'Beth' Boone, a Miami Shores resident, has lead Miami Light Project (MLP) for twenty years. This distinction has made her one of the foremost Arts Influencers in our Greater Miami Arts Community.

What sets this venue apart from others, is its redefining traditional notions of performance. Frequent programs, past and future, include dance, music, theatre, film and multi-media. Many are a combination of forms. Music pervades all.

Founded in 1998, at a kitchen table, by Caren Rabbino and Janine Gross, this tour de force has set the standard by fostering performance inventions through its open, encouraging artists' gestation process. Tarell Alvin McCraney's semi-autobiographical play In Moonlight Black Boys Look Blue, was adapted into the Academy Award winning movie Moonlight. McCraney was mentored and inspired as a result of Miami Light Project's experimental, creative influences. The musical Nu Deco Ensemble, a virtuosic and eclectic chamber orchestra designed for the 21st century (created by, and in residence at MLP) recently performed with Miami Shores' St. Martha Concert Series at Barry University.

MLP, for the past 30 years, has committed to partnerships and collaborations with other cultural organizations such as Arts for Learning/Miami, Miami Theater Center, FUNDarte, Miami-Dade College, O Cinema, Guitars over Guns, and PATH, just to mention a few. MLP also mentors and encourages students from New World School of the Arts, Miami Arts Charter School and New World Symphony.

One of its important tenets is outreach to communities with no access to the arts. This cherished passion has led to interfaces with community organizations in Allapatta, Edgewater, Liberty City, Little Haiti, Little Havanna, and Overtown. MLP travels to these neighborhoods and invites residents to workshops with world renowned artists and performers at MLP's studioperformance center. Students receive free tickets to performances and get a sneak peak, behind the scenes, of the performance arts process.

and greet the actors/performers at an informal, in-the-street affair with food trucks. Many times, the VIBE 305 truck is serving. This is an inspiring entrepreneurial venture by Empowered Youth, a public not-for-profit organization dedicated to enhancing the lives of inner-city, at-risk youth. The food truck is the students' enterprise, with menu development, preparing and serving the goodies, managing the expenses, and turning a profit. MLP partners with this organization, offering







Signature programming includes two exclusive projects: Here & Now, commissioning programs for and by Miami-based artists. Their new works are developed in residence and presented annually in a festival format. Their Contemporary Performance Series brings performers from around the world to both perform and inspire our local community.

Miami Light Project's Light Box is not far, located centrally in Wynwood. Nearby are great food and gathering establishments. The Light Box performance studio-theatre itself serves both alcoholic and soft beverages to take into the theatre and enjoy with the performance. After performances the audience can meet



free Saturday afternoon films centered on life-learning themes followed by participatory 'talk back' sessions with arts professionals.




