BakehouseArt Complex

Discover exciting new artwork, with 60 resident artists right around the corner!

Artists interpret our world through their images and imaginations, in color, for us to experience.

Bakehouse Art Complex, an artist enclave, houses over 60 individual studios with artists working daily. Art enthusiasts troll the hallways searching for a signature work. Museum curators, journalists, other artists and members of the cultural community attend the open exhibits and spend time with resident talent. Collectors enjoy the thrill as they meet new artists and learn the philosophies and passions expressed in their works. There are many art disciplines to be found, including painting, photography, sculpture, ceramics, metal, glass, textiles, video and performance art.

Several well-known and acclaimed South Florida artists are residents or alumni, including but not limited to Robert Chambers, Xavier Cortada, Maria-Martinez Cana, Michelle Lisa Pollissant, Adler Guerrier, Christina Pettersson, Sandra Ramos, and Troy Simmons. There are also two permanent installations: an original Purvis Young mural on it's east wall and the iconic bakery silos which can be seen

from I-95.

This exciting organization houses artists in a welcoming work space where they can exchange ideas, explore potentials and support each other. The artists are voted in by local curators, collectors and established artists, vetting applicants for seriousness of practice, need for and use of space, and merit of work. BAC Board of Directors provides oversight, and helps raise the necessary funds to operate the facility and sponsors its installations and public programs. Throughout the year, galleries and public spaces showcase the talent within.

The BAC founding roster included Helene Muller Pancoast, Faith Atlas, George Fishman, Nathalie and David Nadel. They spearheaded a large group of artists, many from Coconut Grove, once Miami's counter-culture hub. They sought funding after the Coconut Grove building they

artists, so they would not be displaced due to gentrification and real estate booms. The original funding came from city of Miami and Miami-Dade County Community Development Block Grants, designated to stimulate physical and economic development in then-blighted neighborhoods.

Since its inception in 1986, this nonprofit 501(c)(3) organization has enabled and encouraged artistic creativity through diversity and collaboration. The Bakehouse provides juried emerging and mid-career artists with affordable studio spaces, exhibition opportunities, educational and artist advancement programming and common workshop spaces in Miami's historic Art Deco bakery building. As a cultural hub in the Wynwood arts area, the Bakehouse is a venue for conversations and critical thought, open to the public 12-5 p.m. daily and for monthly exhibition events.

Future plans anticipate maximizing the use of the 2.3-acre site to increase spaces for artists. Already in progress, is the reinvigoration or its studio residency and public programming, announced in its bold new building colors.
